# INTRODUCTION

The University of Gwadar (UG) is a multidisciplinary public-sector institution established by the Government of Balochistan in 2021 and located at Sarawan Avenue, New Town Phase-IV, District Gwadar. Prior to becoming an autonomous university, UG operated as a sub-campus of the University of Turbat from 2017 to 2021. The University of Gwadar Act was passed by the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan in 2018, received gubernatorial assent, and was notified in the Provincial Gazette in 2019.

The establishment of UG as an independent university reflects the collective efforts of the Higher Education Commission, federal and provincial governments, public representatives, civil society, and dedicated campus staff. Under the founding leadership of Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir, TI, Vice-Chancellor, and Dr. Syed Manzoor Ahmed, Pro Vice-Chancellor, the university has made rapid institutional progress and emerged as one of the fastest-growing higher education institutions in the region.

Currently, UG comprises two faculties with eight academic departments, serving over 1,000 students. The university is supported by approximately 60 qualified faculty and administrative staff members committed to research-led teaching and student development. UG promotes inclusive education, with a particular focus on empowering the youth of Balochistan, especially from Gwadar and surrounding underdeveloped districts.

The university offers modern academic and residential facilities, including classrooms, lecture theaters, laboratories, libraries, hostels, and student support centers, along with high-speed internet connectivity through the Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN). UG actively promotes student engagement through academic, professional, and extracurricular activities such as seminars, training programs, sports events, and skill-development initiatives.

UG ensures academic quality through a fully functional Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) in compliance with HEC standards, while the Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC) promotes research, innovation, and industry collaboration. The Financial Aid Office administers multiple scholarships to support deserving students and enhance access to higher education.

With strong governance mechanisms, expanding academic programs, and a clear strategic vision, the University of Gwadar is committed to delivering quality education, advancing research, and contributing to the socio-economic development of Balochistan and Pakistan.

# Quality Enhancement Cell

## Introduction

The Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) at the University of Gwadar was established in 2017 to enhance the quality of teaching and learning across various programs of the university. It works to improve the overall quality of education by identifying areas that need development and promoting better learning experiences.

## Continuous Quality Improvement Framework at UG

At the University of Gwadar, quality assurance is guided by a Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) framework that ensures ongoing enhancement rather than one-time compliance. CQI is implemented through systematic follow-up on corrective actions informed by internal and external inputs, including stakeholder feedback, program self-assessments, accreditation processes, and institutional performance reviews. This approach embeds quality as a continuous cycle of review, action, and improvement.

## Quality Assurance Activities During the Year

The QEC carried out focused quality assurance activities to strengthen academic programs and institutional effectiveness. These activities emphasized review, corrective actions, and continuous academic enhancement.

## Self-Assessment and Program Review

In line with HEC's Pakistan Precepts, Standards, and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (PSG-2023), the QEC facilitated the development and evaluation of Self-Assessment Reports (SARs) based on the Eight (8) standards of Program Review for Effectiveness and Enhancement (PREE) framework. During the year, SARs were prepared, reviewed, and evaluated for all the undergraduate programs.

## Review of Institutional Performance and Enhancement

As part of institutional-level quality assurance, the University of Gwadar conducted its first Review of Institutional Performance and Enhancement (RIPE) with the participation of external reviewers. This review provided a comprehensive evaluation of institutional governance, academic processes, and quality assurance mechanisms. The recommendations emerging from the RIPE are being addressed through structured follow-ups within the CQI framework to strengthen institutional effectiveness and sustainability.

## Quality Governance through UGQC Meetings

The University of Gwadar Quality Circle (UGQC) is the central governance body for quality assurance and Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI). Through its quarterly meetings, the UGQC reviewed QEC activities, self-assessment results, stakeholder feedback, and institutional review observations. These meetings enabled informed decision-making on quality priorities and ensured institutionally anchored CQI planning and follow-up, with all proceedings formally documented for consistency and continuity.

# Office for Research, Innovation & Commercialization

## Introduction

The Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC) at the University of Gwadar was established in line with HEC guidelines to promote research excellence and commercialization. In 2025, faculty published over 75 research papers in HEC-recognized national and international journals with a combined impact factor exceeding 150. ORIC also manages two academic journals—Gwadar Social Sciences Review (GSSR), which has published four issues and is pursuing HEC Category ‘Y’ accreditation, and the Gwadar Journal of Applied Sciences, Engineering, and Technology.

During the year, ORIC secured a PKR 5 million NAHE-HEC grant for two capacity-building programs, facilitated faculty and staff participation in national and international conferences, and signed more than 10 MoUs with national organizations. ORIC is in the final stages of formal HEC recognition. In December 2025, ORIC leadership visited Chinese universities and multinational corporations under HEC-CPEC support to explore international collaboration opportunities. ORIC also annually organizes a Job Fair in January, connecting graduates with national and international employers.

# Directorate Finance (OVERVIEW)

The Directorate of Finance serves as a key administrative unit of the University of Gwadar, overseeing financial management, budgeting, and stewardship to support the University’s academic and strategic goals while ensuring transparency and fiscal discipline. The University is primarily funded through Provincial Grant-in-Aid, supplemented by growing own-source revenues. Effective budgetary controls during FY 2023–24 and FY 2024–25 maintained financial stability with a marginal surplus. For FY 2025–26, total resources are projected at PKR 364.990 million, with expenditures focused on salaries, operations, and essential academic and digital infrastructure to support sustainable institutional growth.

## Overview

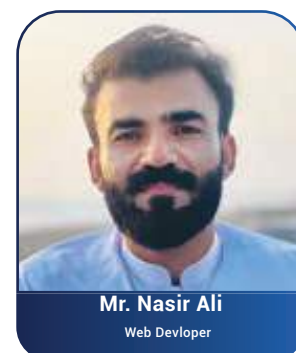

## Project Summary – Establishment of University of Gwadar (Phase-I)

### Project Summary – Establishment of University of Gwadar (Phase-I)

The Government of Pakistan, in its fiscal year 2022-23, has approved a 2.5 billion Project for the “Establishment of University of Gwadar Phase-I”. The Project was approved by the Central Development Working Party on 5 December 2022, while the administrative approval was granted on 10 February 2023, with a total estimated cost of approximately Rs. 2.5 billion and an implementation period of 36 months. The Government of Balochistan had already allocated 500 acres of land for the University near Shabi Pishukan, out of which 100 acres are being utilized in the first phase for the development of core facilities. The scope of Phase-I includes the construction of the Boundary Wall, Gate House, a comprehensive Academic Block, a complete Admin staff Block, Student (both male and female) and Bachelor Hostels, and External Development Works. The consultancy services for Master Planning, Drawing and Design Development, preparation of Engineering Estimates, Tender and Bidding documents, and Supervision of Construction Work were awarded to M/s National Engineering Services Pakistan (Pvt.) Limited. The project has achieved approximately 80% physical progress, reflecting significant advancement towards establishing essential academic and residential facilities at the University of Gwadar. The remaining civil of the Project is progressing in fast track, with the projection that by the end of the current fiscal year, all components of the Phase-I shall be completed and handed over to the University. The University has planned to shift to its newly constructed Campus and will carry on its academic activities from the next academic year, 2026-2027. Upon the completion of Phase-I, the University has prepared a comprehensive PC-I for the development of Phase II of the Project. Phase-II will contain some of the essential components to cater to the needs of academic, residential, and infrastructural needs of the University. The Project of Phase-II, worth around 2.5 billion, has been submitted to the HEC for consideration and approval in the upcoming fiscal year. The University is Master planned and designed by renowned architects of the Consulting Firm, NESPAK, making it one of the most attractive campuses in the country. The physical infrastructure is designed to make it environmentally friendly and sustainable, with historical reflection of Gwadar and this region.

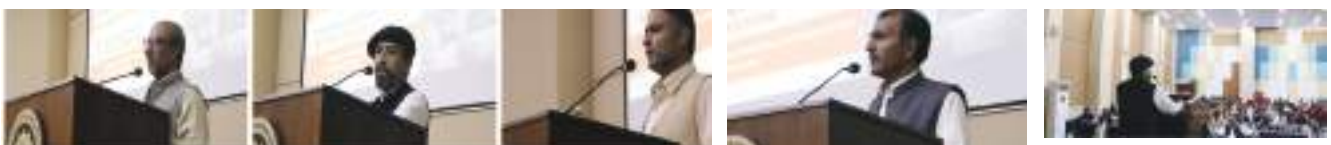
