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INTRODUCTION

The University of Gwadar is a multidisciplinary public sector general university, chartered by the government of Balochistan in 2021, located at Sarawan Avenue New Town Phase-IV District Gwadar. The Charter of the University was passed by the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan on 3rd November 2018, assented to by the Honorable Governor Balochistan on 19th November 2018 and was notified in the Provincial Gazette on 20th October 2019. Before converting into an autonomous university, it remained a Sub-Campus of the University of Turbat (UoT) from 2017 to 2021 with four teaching departments established in the building of Govt Degree College Gwadar.

The Gwadar Campus of the University of Turbat (UoT) was upgraded into a full-fledged university in 2021 as the UG due to the efforts and support of the campus employees, HEC, Federal & Provincial Governments, public representatives of the area, and civil society. Now the University has Two faculties with Seven departments. Prof. Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir (TI) and Dr. Syed Manzoor Ahmed took over as first & founder Vice Chancellor, and Pro Vice Chancellor of the university respectively. While Mr. Dolat Khan and Mr. Shafi Muhammad served as the first Registrar and first Treasurer respectively. Within a short time, the Vice-chancellor, with the support of qualified faculty members and a smart working administrative staff, succeeded in enlisting UG among the fast-growing institute of higher education in the country.

The main objective of the university is to provide quality higher education to the people of the province, mainly the remote and backward areas of Balochistan in districts Gwadar, and neighboring districts to bring them at par with other parts of the province, and the country. The University of Gwadar offers admission to aspirants from across the country without any discrimination in caste, creed, color, and race. The university buildings consist of academic blocks, classrooms, lecture theaters, video conference halls, Computer labs, Cafeteria, student facilitation center, admin blocks, bachelor's hostels, library, and a seminar hall. The University has been at the front line in the efforts to create new vistas of knowledge for the youth of the region. Students from all over Balochistan and Gwadar district in particular are keen to take admitted to this rapidly rising university. Around 60 highly qualified faculty members and administrative staff are making their utmost efforts in providing quality education and enhancing the entrepreneurial skills of around than 1000 students. The faculty members are providing research-led teaching to the students enabling them to become exceptional individuals equipped with advanced knowledge for playing vibrant roles in the development of the nation. To introduce the students to new ideas the University has organized many seminars, workshops, training sessions, Paigham-e-Pakistan events, literary and academic events, international lecture series, certification courses in IT and entrepreneurship, business galas, sports festivals, book fairs, and study and exposure visits. The university through Financial Aid Office is providing financial assistance to its students through Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship, BEEF scholarship, HEC Need-Based scholarship, UG merit-based Scholarship, Pakistan Baitulmal scholarship, and other scholarships sponsored by philanthropists and organizations such as the Chinese Ambassador

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Scholarship The University has successfully held meetings of its statuary bodies frequently. During the first year of its existence, the university has conducted two Academic Council meetings, two finance and Planning committee meetings, and two meetings of the Syndicate. The Senate of the university has expected in the first week of January 2023. The university is well-connected to Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN). Through Its IT department. The PERN provides fast Internet connectivity services to the student's faculty members and staff. Besides Seminar libraries in each department, the university also has a main library with more than 3,000 books on different subjects.

The Quality Enhancement Cell in the university is fully functional as per HEC guidelines working towards creating high-quality standers for academic teaching and research. Besides conducting faculty training & development workshops, the QEC also prepares self-assessment reports and conducts teacher evaluations. The University has signed several MoUs with leading national and international universities and educational and research institutions for the exchange of research skills, knowledge, and expertise. The Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC) is striving to establish strong links with the industry to understand the marketplace for future job opportunities for students.

The University is already publishing a Bi-annual newsletter "GWADARIAN" which is a symbol of distinction for the University and a great achievement. Furthermore, a career counseling and students' affairs cell has been established to help the students to resolve job-related issues such as finding work and setting career goals. Many ideas and projects have been proposed as part of the short- and long-term strategic plan of the University.

The proposed projects include introducing maritime and market-oriented programs of studies, sending more faculty members abroad for higher education, training, refresher courses, starting new departments such as English, Chemistry, Economics, and new programs such as Data Science, B.Ed. 2.5 and 1.5 years and 1-year diploma programs in different disciplines, and hosting national and international conferences, are among the main mission of the future road map of Gwadar University.













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The historic 1st Senate meeting of Gwadar University

Directorate Finance

Salient Features:

The project "Establishment of University of Gwadar Phase-I" approved by CDWP on 10th December 2023 and Admin approval was granted on December 12th, 2023. The total cost of the project is Rs.2499.300 million. Rs.350 million were allocated in the Federal PSDP for the FY 2022-23 which was later revised to Rs. 50M. For the current FY 2023-24 an amount of Rs.400M is allocated in Federal PSDP. The project has provisions for Civil works as well as for other operational and administrative cost such as purchase of various equipment, furniture & Fixtures, books and journal, transport and security system, salaries for faculty, administrative staff and project execution staff and miscellaneous operational expenses.

Budget Estimates for FY 2024-25

The University has prepared the budget estimates for the FY 2024-25 amounting Rs.471.5 M. The budget is placed in the coming meeting of Finance & Planning Committee for recommendation and Syndicate of the university for approval.

Pension Fund

The university has established Pension Fund and opened a saving bank account in National Bank of Pakistan. The pension being deducted from the salaries of the staff is being deposited in the account.

Employee Fund

The university has established Employee Fund and opened a saving bank account in National Bank of Pakistan. The Benevolent Fund, GP Fund and insurance amount being deducted from the salaries of the staff is being deposited in the account.

Research Fund

The university has established a Research & Innovation Fund. An amount of around Rs.20 million is so far invested in the fund.

Grant-in-Aid

For the current financial year, the University Finance Commission Government of Balochistan sanctioned an amount of Rs. 164 million has been sanctioned as Grant-in-Aid for the university. The University is utilizing the said grant for pay and allowances and other operational expenses.

Financial Aid Office, University of Gwadar. is established in order to facilitate talented and less privileged students for grant of scholarship on merit and need based. Mr. Shayhaq, Lecturer Department of Computer Science, is the current Focal Person of the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships, University of Gwadar. This Office is dealing with multiple Need Based and Merit Based Scholarships. Currently the office is dealing major with four Scholarship programs including HEC Need Based Scholarship. Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship Project, Baluchistan Education Endowment Fund (BEEF) and Pakistan Bait-Ul-Maal. Under The HEC Need Based Scholarship



program, the office has provided 30 Scholarship to the students from session 2019 to 2021, These Scholarships were provided to the bachelor students of various disciplines within the UG. Under Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship Project, the office has provided 150 scholarship to BS students of various discipline from 2019 to 2020. Moreover, under Baluchistan Education Endowment Fund Merit Based Scholarship program, 100 students were awarded scholarships of announced policy of 2019 to 2021. Furthermore, Pakistan Bait-UI Mall has provided 25 scholarships to needy students so far.




