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Mega Jirga Held in PCT&VI Gwadar to Address Local Issues, Chaired by Chief Minister Balochistan



A grand jirga was convened on June 18 at the Pak-China Vocational and Technical Institute, University of Gwadar, led by Balochistan Chief Minister Mir Sarfraz Bugti and Commander 12 Corps Lt Gen Rahat Naseem Ahmed Khan. Moderated by Pro VC Dr. Syed Manzoor Ahmed, the session brought together tribal elders, political leaders, institutional heads, faculty, students, and civil society to discuss pressing local issues including economic challenges, inadequate educational facilities, and illegal trawling along the Gwadar coast.

Participants strongly advocated for the protection of local resource rights and demanded urgent, lasting solutions. Responding promptly, the Chief Minister directed relevant departments to take immediate action and addressed student concerns on the spot—offering a motor scooter to a female student and ordering the immediate allocation of a girls' hostel for university use.

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University of Gwadar 2nd Senate meeting



The 2nd Senate meeting of the University of Gwadar was held on March 6th at the Governor House in Quetta, chaired by Governor of Balochistan and Chancellor Jafar Khan Mandokhel. He emphasized the need for transparency, accountability, and timely audits in university governance. The Governor urged Vice Chancellors to conduct regular statutory meetings and ensure smooth examinations. 


UG Reviews Progress on Self-Assessment and Institutional Performance
