

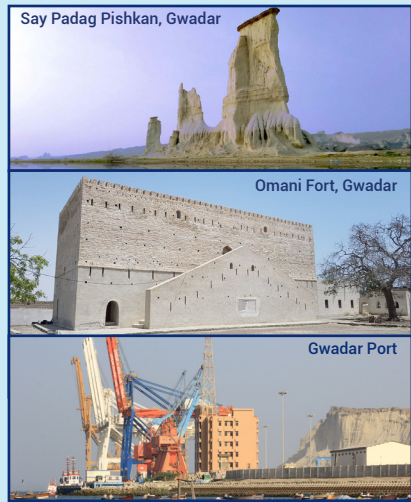

In accordance with University of Gwadar Act 2018, the Vice Chancellors of both universities mutually agreed to transfer the existing properties, staff, buildings, books, furniture & fixture, rights, liabilities, and other assets of UoT's Gwadar Campus to University of Gwadar. University of Gwadar

formally came into being in the last week of October 2021. The Gwadar Campus of University of Turbat was officially absorbed into University of Gwadar. Honorable Chancellor/Governor Balochistan had appointed Prof. Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir as Vice Chancellor of University of Gwadar and Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir assumed the office as the first Vice Chancellor of university on 29th October 2021. The Vice Chancellor of University of Turbat Prof. Dr Jan Muhammad assured full support to his counterpart Prof. Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir for the development of University of Gwadar. He served for four years in Jordan as a scholar for Quaid-i-Azam Chair in Urdu and Pakistan Studies at University of Jordan Amman and served as the education, culture

and media coordinator (Attaché) of the Pakistan Embassy in Jordan. He also served as Director of Balochistan Study Centre and Chairman of Faculty of Training and Development Centre, University of Balochistan. His research articles were published in journals of the US, Japan, UK, Sweden, Italy, India, Jordan and Libya. He is also the author of various books and was honored with Tamgha-i-Imtiaz by the government of Pakistan on his diplomatic, academic and literary services.
